



Dementia Australia chairman "heartbroken" by aged care report findings

Chairman of Dementia Australia Graeme Samuel says he is "heartbroken" by an interim report into the aged care industry that described the system as "cruel", "harmful", and a "tale of neglect".

"It's very difficult to control the emotions," he told Sky News, adding he was "heartbroken, ashamed, and angry" at the findings.

"I'm a part of a community that after 18 reviews over the past two decades, has still allowed our aged people to be treated in this most disgraceful manner.

"It can't continue."

The interim report was released on Thursday.
